About PCD Foundation

The PCD Foundation was founded by a PCD parent and a PCD patient in 2002. As a patient-focused organization, the goal of the PCD Foundation is to provide the leadership and resources needed to support increased research, accelerated diagnosis, improved health, and ultimately, a cure for PCD.

The PCD Foundation has developed the PCD Foundation Clinical & Research Centers Network (PCDF - CRCN) to serve as focal points for PCD diagnosis, research, treatment, and data collection. This network ensures that PCD patients receive quality diagnostics and cutting-edge treatment and care, all based on evidence and/or expert consensus. At participating PCDF - CRCN sites, patients may have the opportunity to enroll in the PCD Foundation Registry (PCDFR), which collects important health and demographic information about individuals with PCD. This information is used to assist healthcare teams to provide care to individuals with PCD, drive quality improvement initiatives at care centers, and create PCD care guidelines. Researchers may also use information from the PCDFR to study PCD treatments and outcomes and to design PCD clinical trials.
